

Create a Daily Reminder Message

Question: We need a daily reminder that can be called up when we start WordPerfect in the morning. How can I do this?

Answer:

Use the included REMINDER.WPM macro. Once you've copied it to your Macros directory, you can change the message at any time. Simply press (Ctrl-10), type "reminder," press E, then edit the first five lines. Press F7 to exit the macro editor.

You can have WordPerfect run the reminder macro when you enter WordPerfect each day by starting the program with a start-up option. To use the start-up option, start WordPerfect by typing "wp/m-reminder.wpm" at the DOS prompt.

Most menu systems also allow you to include start-up options on your program's command line. For instance, in Shell 4.0, highlight WordPerfect on the list of programs. Press Edit Item (F6), (6) Advanced Options, (1) Command Line Options and type "/m-reminder.wpm." Press (Enter) three times to return to the menu. When you start WordPerfect with the run macro start-up option, the specified macro will be invoked automatically.

*Note: To remove the reminder message from the screen, press any key.*
